How to renew a business license through the Town online portal?

1. Log into the online service portal with your username and password.

- 4. The system will automatically bring up your application. Check all the fields and make necessary changes before clicking the "submit" button. Make sure to change the "Kiawah gross sales" to whatever your company's Kiawah revenue was for the previous calendar year.
 - All general contractors, residential contractors, subcontractors, and specialty contractors need to make sure to upload current copies of their SC State Contractor License/Registration Cards and the Driver's License of the person who is listed on the SC Contractors License even if the system shows something already there. New copies must be uploaded each year. The system will not allow you to submit your renewal application until this is done.
- 5. Once submitted, your application will go through review. Be on the lookout for email updates from Town staff.
