Agricultural land, for purposes of this exemption, is defined as "a tract containing a minimum of five contiguous commercial acres (175,000 SF) which is being used for the production of farm, garden, or orchard crops, or the grazing or raising of farm animals, including feeding pens that are incidental and subordinate to a grazing operation." An agricultural zoning exemption allows for land to be used without being subject to use regulations and safety codes. Applicants must demonstrate eligibility for an agricultural exemption by producing verifiable evidence of active commercial agricultural status. In addition, a reasonable operating profit must be possible from its agricultural use. Physical inspections may be conducted to substantiate the use as agricultural.
