Home Occupation is defined in the Cochise County Zoning Regulations as an activity carried on by the occupant of a dwelling as a secondary use, including personal and professional services. It is subject to the following regulations:

- A. The Home Occupation may occupy an area no greater than one-quarter (¼) of the floor area of the residence, whether occurring within the residence or in a detached structure.
- B. Employees Allowed:
 - 1. Residents of the primary dwelling.
 - 2. Immediate family members, including spouse, child, sibling, parent, grandparent, grandchild, stepchild, or stepsibling, whether related by adoption or blood.
 - 3. Maximum of two individuals who do not meet the criteria B.1 or B.2
- C. Any outdoor display or storage of materials, goods, supplies, or equipment shall be prohibited, other than the signs noted below.
- D. The generation of noise, vibrations, noxious odors, dust, heat, or glare detectable beyond any property line or the storage or use of hazardous materials of a type and amount that could create

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- safety concerns or are not appropriate to dispose of in residential garbage or sewer systems is prohibited.
- E. No parking or delivery activity that causes on-street parking congestion or a substantial increase in traffic through the residential area.
- F. There shall be no change to the residential appearance of the premises.
- G. There shall be allowed one on-site non-illuminated permanent sign not to exceed four square feet with a maximum height of five feet, and vehicular signs.

How a Home Occupation Application is Processed

- 1. The property owner or authorized agent completes and submits this application to the Planning Division.
- 2. The application is reviewed. The applicant is informed in writing whether the application was approved or denied.

Is a Home Occupation Permit the Same as a Business License?

No. Approval for a Home Occupation from the County provides the property owner permission to conduct a proposed activity on a specific property. It's intended to prevent a business from adding significant traffic, noise, or other zoning concerns such as dust or odors that would interfere with the surrounding homeowners' use and enjoyment of their property. This is not the same as a business license, and it does not confirm or acknowledge that someone is conducting a business from a taxing standpoint.
